ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, rules have been issued for Andhra Pradesh Private Colleges of Nursing (Grant of Permission to Private Colleges or Institutions and Admissions into B.Sc. Nursing Course) Rules, 1997. In the G.O. third read above certain amendments have been issued to the said rules. According to the revised procedure, the Selection Committee for Para Medical Institutions constituted by Government will conduct the inspection of the applicant Institution of B.Sc. Nursing and forward its recommendations along-with Inspection report. The payment of security deposit by the proposed Private institutions has been dispensed with and an Annual affiliation fee to be paid to the N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada by the Institution is however continued.

2. In G.O. second read above, Government have constituted a new committee under the Chairmanship of Justice G.Radhakrishna Rao; retired judge, High Court of Andhra Pradesh and with (9) others as Members to process the applications received from the interested parties for establishment of Para-Medical Institutions and submit its recommendations to Government for taking necessary action.

3. In the D.O. Letter forth read above, the Chairman, Selection Committee has stated that inspection officers were sent for inspection of the applicant Societies and based on inspection reports, the matter was placed before the Selection Committee at its meeting held on. 18-07-2003 and forwarded its recommendations to Government in respect of four educational societies with an intake capacity of forty (40) students for each Institute taking necessary action.

4. After careful consideration of the matter and in exercise of the powers conferred under sub rule (ii) of rule 15 of Andhra Pradesh Private Colleges of Nursing (Grant of Permission to Private Colleges or Institutions and Admissions into B.Sc. Nursing Course) Rules, 1997 made under section 99 of Andhra Pradesh Education Act, 1982 (Act 1 of 1982), Government hereby accord permission to the following four educational societies to establish the institutes as mentioned below and to start degree course in B.Sc. Nursing of four years duration with an intake capacity of forty (40)

5. The permission accorded in para (4) above is subject to the following conditions: -

- (1) That the Institute should obtain affiliation duly fulfilling all the conditions stipulated as per the statutes of the N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh and payment of annual affiliation fee as may be prescribed from time to time to N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada and clearance from the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi. In case the aforesaid Educational Society fails to fulfill the conditions or fails to start the B.Sc. Nursing course within a period of one year, the permission now accorded will be cancelled.
- (2) The annual intake of students should not exceed forty (40) students to each Institute and the institute should fulfill and abide the rules and regulations notified by Government in G.O.Ms. No.145 HM&FW (M2) Department dated, 18-05-1998 / G.O.Ms.No.76 HM&FW (K2) Dept., dated.28-03- 2003 and amendments issued thereon from time to time.

6. The aforesaid Educational Society should also follow the following instructions scrupulously:

- (i) The Institute should run regularly with the required infrastructural facilities, equipments, teaching staff, office rooms and clinical facilities, hostel facility, library books as per the statutes and regulations of N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada and as per the regulations of the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and should run in the best interests of students.
- (ii) The students hostels, wherever provided are adequately furnished with appropriate areas for their comfortable stay and provision is made for their indoor or outdoors games.
- (iii) The fees collected by whatsoever name called either for free seats or for management seats do not exceed the limits specified in the Government order or statutes and regulations of N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada and regulations of Indian Nursing Council.

The procedure prescribed by Government or N.T.R. U.H.S., for the selection and admission of students, rule of reservation, local - non-local areas, conducting examinations should be scrupulously followed.

- (v) The Education Society should not issue any advertisement calling for admission into training institution or make any admissions till after the Registrar NTR UHS, grants his permission and provisional affiliation to it to establish the college and save in accordance with the rules governing the issue of such advertisement and making the selections.
- (vi) The Institute should not have or open branches on the same place or elsewhere in the State or out side State.

7. The Government of Andhra Pradesh /NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada/ Director of Medical Education Hyderabad/ Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi shall depute an inspecting officer to the Institute for a surprise quarterly check or as may be required.

8. The permission granted in para (4) above is liable for cancellation whenever the Government or NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada or Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi forms the opinion that the aforementioned Educational Societies are not running the college in the best interests of the students or commits any irregularity or violates any rule / regulation after giving 15 days notice to the Educational Society to show cause, against the proposed cancellation and pass appropriate orders after considering the explanation, if any, offered by the Society against the show cause notice.

9. The infrastructure and other facilities available / to provided by the Educational Society in the college are enclosed as Annexure to this G.O.

10. The Registrar, NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada shall communicate the final decision of acceptance or rejection of affiliation and recognition to the aforementioned Educational Society, as the case may be within a period of three months from the date of issue of this order .
